The development of **Area Fellowships** is a central priority of EFAC-USA's redevelopment, recognizing that fellowship and mutual support are vital for healthy gospel ministry. We seek volunteer **Area Fellowship Coordinators** to establish and lead these strategic local networks.

Person Description

We are looking for someone who is:

- 1. A committed Anglican or Episcopal evangelical and EFAC-USA member, affirming our Statement of Faith and Aims.
- 2. Known for qualities that invite and encourage others into fellowship.
- 3. Able to lead and organize group activities, or delegate effectively.
- 4. Committed to collaboration with the EFAC-USA Board and available for the annual national workshop of coordinators.

Position Description

The Area Fellowship Coordinator will:

- 1. Initiate and coordinate a local EFAC-USA fellowship, alone or ideally with a co-leader.
- 2. Develop a regular program of fellowship, prayer, Bible study, and ministry encouragement.
- 3. Explore and support the growth of evangelical ministry in the area.
- 4. Use EFAC-USA resources and branding in communications and gatherings.
- 5. Work in accountability to the EFAC-USA Board in all matters, including finance and safeguarding.
- 6. Serve for a renewable three-year term.

Area Fellowships may vary in size and format—meeting in homes, churches, online, or around meals. Beyond regular gatherings, coordinators may organize occasional teaching or witness events. The shared aim is to strengthen evangelical leaders and ministries through prayer, fellowship, and Scripture.
